Rubber Track Operation

- Avoid curbs, large rocks, angle iron or any other sharp objects during operations. If unable to avoid these objects, slow down before crossing the object.
- Always keep the undercarriage free of debris, dirt and mud to insure that it will operate correctly.
- Avoid operating in salt or oils, as these will deteriorate the rubber tracks.
- Avoid static turning.
- · Avoid steep side grades.
- Avoid hitting the rubber tracks with the machine bucket.
